

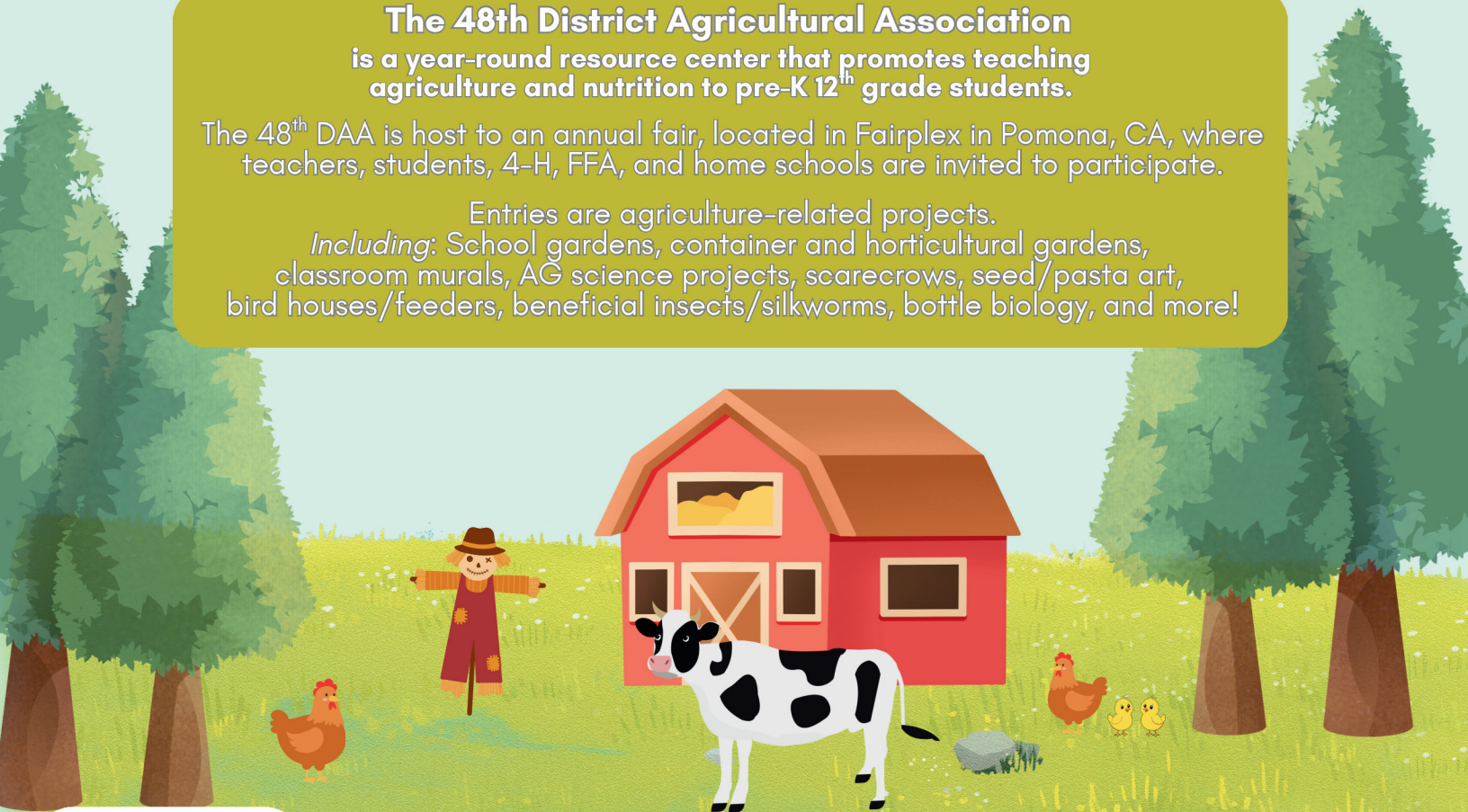
SCHOOLS' AGRICULTURE & NUTRITION FAIR
